What are cookies?

Cookies are small pieces of data that are stored in text files on your mobile device or computer when you visit a website. Cookies allow a website's server to record and store user actions and settings, such as login information, user history, language settings, and other display settings, for a period of time. Cookies ensure that visitors do not have to constantly re-enter their data or information when they revisit the website or browse the pages.

We also use cookies to remember users' preferences for one-time visits via session cookies or for multiple recurring visits via persistent cookies.

How do we use cookies?

Cookies are necessary for the optimal functioning of our website and improve the performance of the website and the user experience. The operators of the website monitor all cookies used on the website and provide access to third parties for statistical and analytical purposes. Cookies are needed so that we do not forget to identify visitors and remember their activities and online behavior on the website.

We use cookies for various reasons, which are described in detail below. We do not use information about cookies to personally identify users.

Cookie settings

Most web browsers support the use of cookies. When setting up your browser, you can manually delete, stop or completely disable individual cookies. You can only enable cookies on certain websites. If you allow the use of cookies in your browser, we assume that you accept the use of standard cookies used by our servers and websites.
